Literacy

The main themes for writing will follow the History and Geography topics for the term. Your child will write in different genres within these topics. These will include a recount, a diary entry, a poster, descriptions and a story based upon another they know. Key aspects of grammar and punctuation will be introduced and developed.

Your child will begin to learn spellings and spelling patterns) from phonic sessions and those stated in the National Curriculum (Common Exception Words).

Support at home with spelling and daily reading would be appreciated.

Geography

London in the present day will be our topic focus for the first part of the term. Your child will begin by learning where London is in the UK and then learn about specific landmarks and what happens in them.

Science

The topic Animals including Humans will be our main focus during Science lessons. Your child will learn facts, develop their understanding and carry out practical investigations.

Art

The main focus this term will be self portraits. Your child will create portraits using different media.

Numeracy

Number and Place value - Count, read and write numbers in numerals and words. Count in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10 forwards and backwards from any given number. Compare and order numbers. Recognise the place value of 2-digit numbers.

Addition and Subtraction - Learn the number bonds to 10 or 20 and related subtractions. Add or subtract multiples of 10 to 2-digit numbers. Solve problems using addition or subtraction.

Shape and measure - recognise and name the common 2-D and 3-D shapes. Find different combinations of coins to make different amounts and use the correct notation. Solve problems using the addition and subtraction of money.

Multiplication and division Yr 2 - Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Solve problems involving multiplication and division.
