Curriculum Information

A booklet for parents

English

During this term our topic will be 'Holidays'. We will read and discuss story books with this theme.

Throughout the term we will write our own stories, instructions, character descriptions and poetry inspired by the stories we read.

In line with the 2014 curriculum your child will also be taught the grammar, punctuation and spelling rules required for their year group.

Reading skills will be developed within phonics, guided reading and individual reading opportunities.

Mathematics

Number and Place value - Counting up to 100, counting on and back in 2s, 5s and 10s. Odd and even numbers.

Addition and Subtraction - Learn number bonds to 10 and related subtractions.

Multiplication and division - Double numbers to 10, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Problem Solving- Solve simple number problems using addition and subtraction facts.

Shape and measure- Recognise 2D and 3D shapes and sort by their properties. Tell the time to an hour or half an hour.

Science

In line with the topics of 'Holidays' your child will learn about the weather and seasonal changes.

Throughout the term we will be developing observation and investigation skills including making a rain gauge.

ICT

During this term your child will develop computer coding skills.

They will use a simple Paint programme to draw a picture on the computer.

They will program Beebots to travel around the classroom floor.

Art

We will look at the work of the artist, Seurat and the sculptor Andy Goldsworthy and recreate our own work influenced by their styles.

We will use a wide range of methods and materials to create our work. We will learn about primary colours and how to mix them to create new colours.
