### Summary of proposed Sports spending 2016/17

- Join Castele Consultancy to become part of the Uttoxeter Sports Partnership.
  1. Through this the children will be able to participate in local activities and competitions in the Uttoxeter pyramid.
  2. Staff will have access to professional development opportunities.
- Buy in a Progressive Sports coach to work alongside staff in school.
- Improve resources.
- Transport to sporting events within the Sports Partnership.
- Provide funding to transport Yr 3 and 4 children to a weekly swimming lesson during the Autumn and Summer Terms.
- To enable a local Sports coach to run a range of After School clubs during the school year.

### Impact of Sports Premium spending 2015/16

- Children have had the opportunity to take part in festivals and competitions with other children in the Uttoxeter pyramid and beyond. This year children have attended Cross Country, Football, Sportshall Athletics, Swimming, Gymnastics, Hi 5 Netball, Tag rugby, Rounders and multiskills.
- The children in Year 3 and 4 have been able to attend a weekly swimming lesson for two terms.
- Children in Year 2, 3 and 4 have been able to attend an After school sports club led By a Sports Coach including Hockey, Indoor Cricket, Dodgeball and tag Rugby.
- School Sports Council have planned and ran an intra school Sports day with support from Caroline Smith from the Sports partnership. All the

children in the school took part in Alternative sports events including Archery, Boccia, Table Tennis, New Age Kurling Sitting Volley ball.

- Children have attended an After school Archery club funded by the Sports Partnership.
- Playground Leaders deliver Active Lunch times twice a week.
